

HEART COZIES

Use up some stash to knit these quick and easy gifts for that special someone!

Skills Needed

General knitting knowledge plus intarsia method of color knitting.

Finished Size

6¾" tall x 13" circumference (vase cozy) or 14.5" circumference (buttoned French press cozy)

Materials

Yarn

Scraps of super bulky. Those used in samples were Rowan Big Wool, Lamb's Pride burly spun.

Notions

For French press cozy, one button 1¾" in diameter.

Needles

One pair #13.

Gauge

It's a vase cozy... do we really care? It's bound to be close enough!

Directions for Vase Cozy

With mc co 31 sts. Knit first 2 rows (garter st). Switch to ST st beginning with a RS row and work 3 rows. Next row (WS) begin heart chart as follows: purl 11 sts, work across 9 sts of chart using intarsia method, purl 11. Cont chart as established, then work a further 3 rows ST st. Work 2 rows garter, then bo k-wise on WS.

Finishing

Block flat, then sew back seam. If you don't have a glass vase to fit, use a 1 liter soda bottle cut shorter than the cozy.

Directions for French Press Cozy

As for vase cozy until piece measures 2". At beg next RS row, co 9 sts. Cont as est with cozy working only these 9 sts in moss st. Work 4 rows this way and in the 5th row, make buttonhole as follows: work 3 sts as est in moss st, bo next 3 sts, work last 3 sts moss st, finish row as est. In next row, co 3 sts over those bound off in previous row. After 11 rows of moss st, bo 9 (moss st) sts at beg (RS) row. Complete knitting as for vase cozy.



Finishing

Block flat. Fit around your French press and mark for button; sew button in place.
